## **Kernel Development**

After the bees pollinate the trees, the petals will fall to the ground, and the almonds grow big and round. During this time, there are three main layers growing, maturing and hardening. The center of the almond, which is the part we eat, is called the **kernel**. Around the kernel is a protective covering called the shell.

The **hull** is the fuzzy green coating, which protects the shell and the kernel.

## **VOCABULARY**

**kernel:** another term for almond

hull: the softgreen, leathery protective covering around the kernel and shell
