By the Numbers

- The Bee Sweet Citrus Fresh Fruit Packing Line and Laboratory is the first of its kind on a college campus, as is the Western Agricultural Producers Association Nut Processing Laboratory.
- Fresno State Winery is the nation's first and largest collegiate winery, producing 4,000 cases of wine each year for local and online sale.
- Fresno State's 1,000-acre farm supports 18 enterprises, including livestock, creamery, crops, nursery, meat science, orchard, vineyard units, the Gibson Farm Market, and is the nation's largest on-campus farm.

Educating Future Leaders

These are just a few of the programs, professors and courses that prepare students to lead and serve their communities:

- Fresno State's **Agricultural Education Credential Program** is highly regarded as the state's best for high school ag teachers. It offers multiple semesters of in-class instruction, access to its nationally-recognized campus farm and mechanized agriculture program, and close ties to a multitude of high school and community college programs.
- In one of Fresno State's most engaging classes, **Food Science and Nutrition Department** students take part in a Dairy Products Innovation Showcase to pitch their test products and samples to California Milk Advisory Board marketing and industry research and development professionals.
- Plant Science Professor Dr. Dave Goorahoo won the **Irrigation Association Excellence in Education Award** for his classes, outreach efforts, and research for over 25 years at Fresno State that have focused on new techniques and technology to grow vegetables more efficiently and sustainably.
- Enology Assistant Professor Dr. Yiliang Cheng's **wine sensory class** teaches students how to evaluate different wine attributes and processing techniques that can influence and enhance winemaking.
